General activities for the <i>Technical profile</i>	<p>Activities related to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - drafting of documents and reports in relation to Programme implementation; - definition and handling of Programme procedures; - drafting of the relevant documents necessary for the Programme implementation (Programme manual, guidelines, etc.); - setting up and day-to day functioning of the IT managing and monitoring system of the Programme; - technical support to the Monitoring Committee meetings and ensure their follow-up; - participation in the events at Programme level; - elaboration of thematic reports, annual reports; - preparation of calls for proposals and the selection procedures; - supporting the project selection procedure by carrying out the relevant assessment steps (admissibility, eligibility and quality checks); - management of projects reporting; - contributing to the monitoring of the Programme; - information to the stakeholders about the Programme and to the beneficiaries during the implementation of the projects.

Evaluation criteria for the comparative procedure	<p>Evaluation criteria of the curriculum and any other documentation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - professional experience in ETC projects or programmes, above the minimum requirement; - specific experience in one or more of the themes targeted by the Specific Objectives of Programme¹; - professional experience in maritime Cross Border Cooperation programmes ; - relevant working experience in an international/multicultural environment; - certified knowledge of English language above the minimum requirement; - knowledge of one or both languages of the Programme area. <p>Evaluation criteria in case of interview:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - good understanding of the EU institutional framework; - sound knowledge of EU regulations and management systems, of ESI funds, with special reference to ETC rules and financial implementation and to Italy - Croatia CBC Programme; - assessment and monitoring procedures in ETC Programmes.
